Community based Pss

- Conduct joint review of good practices of community mobilisation across sectors (PSS, health, education, child protection etc) with a focus on what is relevant to PSS
- Adapting in different settings
- Retraining ourselves on how to facilitate community mobilisation (do no harm)
- Question: how to determine what is good practice?
Need to agree on clear criteria and principles
- Agreeing on principles and then giving specific guidance on how to do it: need specific operationalisation of the process (AS 5.1)

Community PSS urban

- Develop Urban marker to ensure adequate attention to urban settings to mainstream in all PSS? Like Gender marker
- Collection of good practices in urban settings
- Advocacy with government on services in urban settings

Adolescents

- Advocacy material better define how different sectors can meet the development needs of adolescents; opportunities for involvement of adolescents in different sectors; development of benchmarks and then mainstreamed in other sectors guidance
- Good programmes for MHPSS for adolescents to be included in the MHPSS review

Social justice/peacebuilding

- Short brief to include definitions to bridge worlds
- Collecting evidence and case studies on good practices; informal mapping of tools and practices including documentation of local ????or activiies including neglected groups e.g. Interfaiethe discussions, truth, transgenerational dialogue (story telling/narrative/siliencing)
- Engaging stakeholders to introduce PB and CR in schools

Working with other sectors

- Develop practical guidance for sector specific to promote mhps by collaboration with MHPSS actors and relevant sectors; going beyond what should be done (as in MHPSS guidelines) to how
- Conduct review to determine if existing sectoral guidelines adequately include mhps, develop training materials to field test
- Skilling field based mhps personnel to work with other sectors e.g. advocacy, collaboration
- Wanting to invite other sectors to teach us on how to work better with them; ask for their help, rather than coming in as expert e.g. Staff care as entry point
