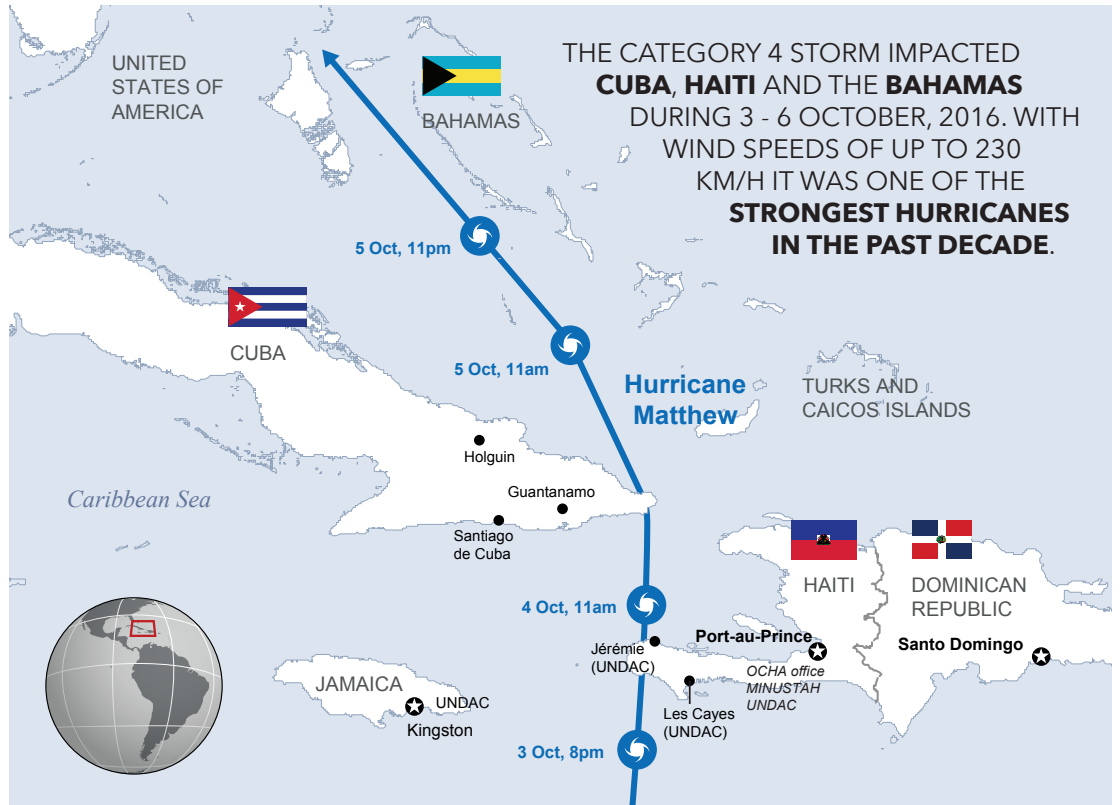

THE CATEGORY 4 STORM IMPACTED **CUBA, HAITI AND THE BAHAMAS** DURING 3 - 6 OCTOBER, 2016. WITH WIND SPEEDS OF UP TO 230 KM/H IT WAS ONE OF THE **STRONGEST HURRICANES IN THE PAST DECADE.**
