



INTER-AGENCY TRAINING PACKAGES¹ MENU –

CASE MANAGEMENT –

Available in **English, Arabic and French**, this package includes the new Case Management Guidelines (2014).

CASE MANAGEMENT – SUPERVISION AND COACHING –

This is an inter-agency training manual on Supervision and Coaching (2018). This training manual enables higher quality interventions for children in need, as caseworkers will be better supported throughout their work. Available in **English, Arabic and French**.

CHILD FRIENDLY SPACES –

With 4 modules and 13 sessions, this training is designed to be either a 3- or 5-day package to ensure quality and standards within CFS programming including mainstreaming.

CHILD PROTECTION RAPID ASSESSMENT (CPRA) v2014 –

Available in **English and French** – This updated package can be delivered in a 3 to 4 day package and includes a training of trainer's component.

CHILD PROTECTION RAPID ASSESSMENT (CPRA) v2014 for ASSESSORS –

As above this CPRA package is adapted specifically for assessors – it is a 3-day package.

CPiE COORDINATION –

Available in **English and French**. Based around the IASC 6 functions of Coordination and the new global guidance, it includes a one-day simulation exercise.

CPiE QUICK / SHORT SESSION –

Available in **English, French and Arabic**, these sessions cover the basic for a quick onset emergency or in a situation where capacity and time is limited. The sessions can be run individually in various formats or combined for a one-day training. Sessions include: PSS, CFS, CPMS, UASC, Code of Conduct, and taking care of yourself.

CPiE FACE TO FACE TRAINING v2014 –

This package is a comprehensive CPiE training based around the CPMS, and the transformative agenda. It includes 42 sessions across 6 modules and can be a 5 to 7 package with an optional one-day simulation.

CPiE FACE TO FACE TRAINING v2015 – with UNHCR –

These are additional sessions added to the v2014 to specifically address Refugee and Mixed Settings.

CPiE FACE TO FACE TRAINING v2018 v1 –

This package is a comprehensive CPiE training based around the CPMS, and the transformative agenda. It includes 42 sessions across 6 modules and can be a 5 to 7 package with an optional one-day simulation. **This full package is also under further revision and will become v2019.**

CPiE STANDBY PARTNERS TRAINING – UNICEF / UNHCR –

For those that will be deployed within the standby partner programs across UNICEF and UNHCR. This is a 6-day CPiE package that includes a simulation exercise.

CPMS FRONTLINE WORKERS –

This package gives an overview of the CPMS and is targeting at field workers. There are 10 sessions that can be contextualised and delivered in 3 days. **This package will be revised after CPMS revision process is complete in 2019.**

TRAINING OF TRAINERS – CPWG PEDAGOGICAL APPROACH –

A one-day workshop targeted at potential trainers and facilitators who will be using the CPWG IA materials. It includes time for 'teach back' and learning to ensure contextualisation of materials to the needs on the ground.

CHILD PROTECTION TRAINING – DPKO – (2015)

Targeted at peacekeepers and those working within UN Missions, this specialised package gives an overview of child protection within these settings. Across 6 modules the aim is to introduce child protection concepts and provide protection missions specific tactical situations for discussion amongst military and police contingent leaders and staff.

IA CHILD DDR TRAINING – 2 Day package –

Targeted at those working on Disarmament, Demobilisation, and Reintegration of children associated with armed forces and / or groups – this training makes suggestions on how the process can be run and can be adapted to on the ground circumstances.

INFORMATION MANAGEMENT – CPWG / EWG v2014 –

Across 6 modules, delivered across 5 days, this training is aimed at IMO's and Coordinators, and gives the participants an understanding of the various tools available and how to use these.

INTERVIEWING CHILDREN –

Using the latest research on the most effective and ethical ways of interviewing children, this package can be delivered in 2 days, which include a practice and assessment component.

PSYCHOSOCIAL FIRST AID -

A one-day package covering the PFA approach including: participatory activities and assessments.

TAKING CARE OF YOURSELF –

Recognising the difficult, stressful and challenging situations that CPiE professionals find themselves, this half day package is designed to challenge the participants to think about their own well-being as well as the well-being of other colleagues.

GRAB BAG – ICE BREAKERS AND ENERGISERS –

To assist all who are delivering training, this grab bag has more than 30 session plans for effective delivery of ice breakers and energisers that can also be applied to the learning being delivered.
