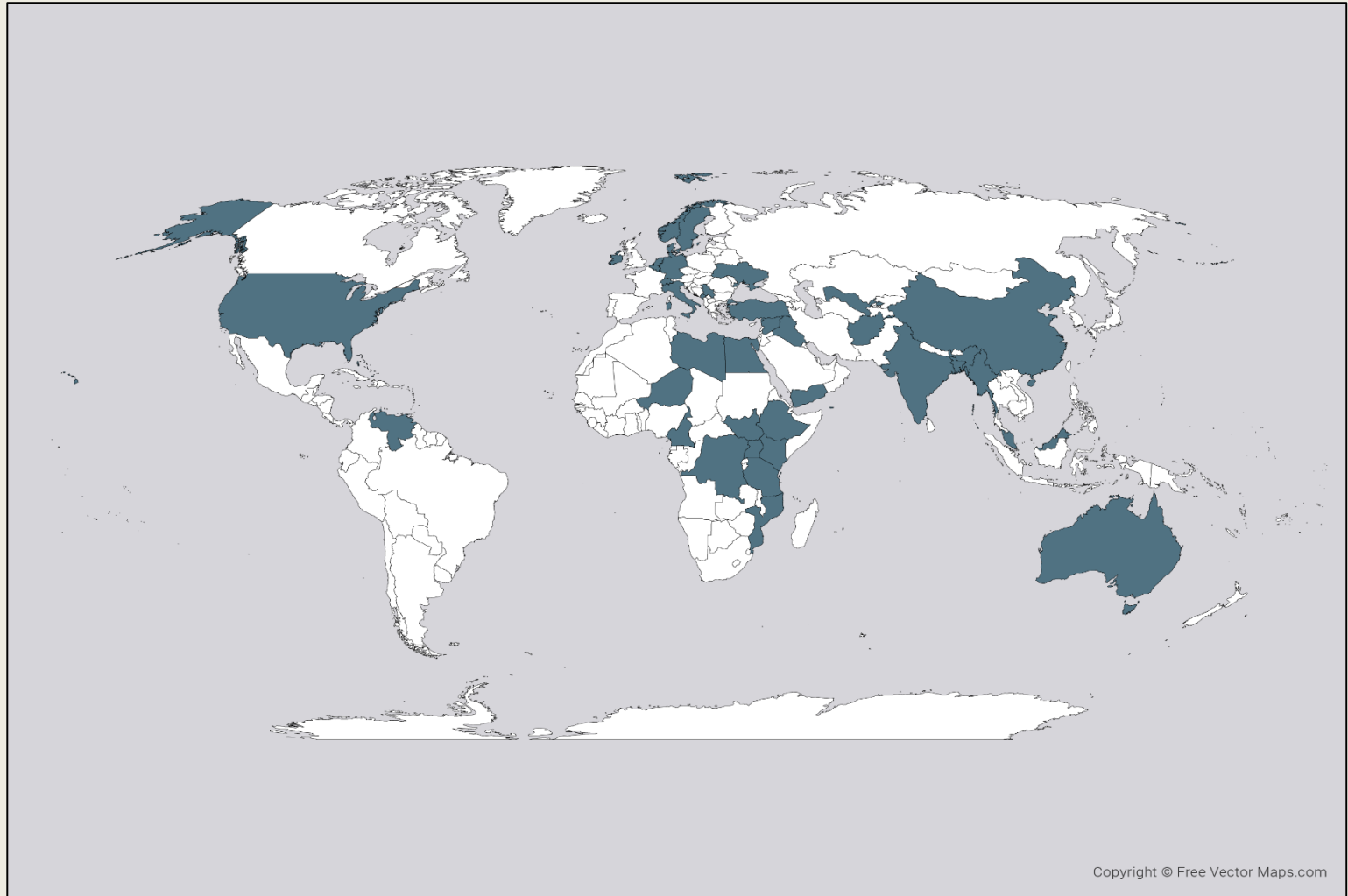

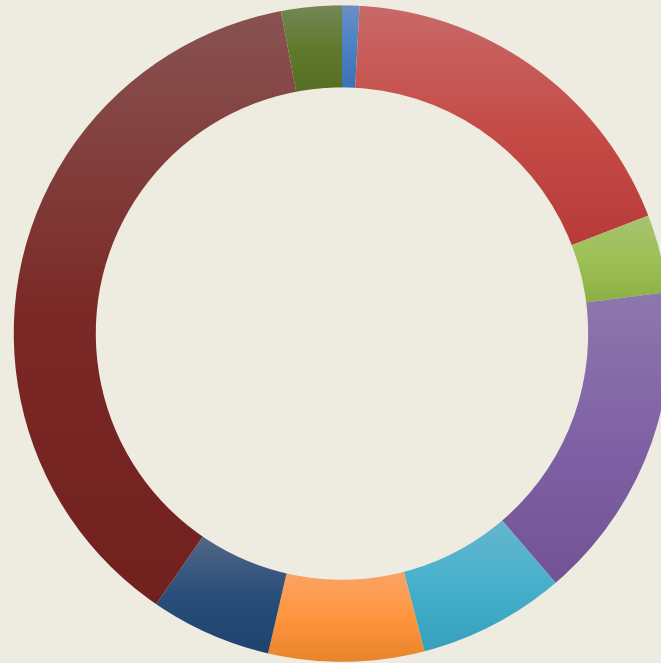
Requests by geographical location
