





Update work process 2019













Background

- Established end of 2017
- Co-Chairs: GIZ, HIAS & Save the Children
- 31 members from 21 different organizations & universities
- Purpose: Gain a deeper understanding of current staff care needs, approaches, challenges and best practices humanitarian aid workers face in their daily work.
 - → focus: support measures of local NGOs for their staff/volunteers
- Final product: recommendations paper











Activities in 2019

- Calls with several agencies and individuals
- ✓ Revision of the ToR
 → focus on local staff and volunteers working with local NGOs
- Online group on MHPSS.net → compilation of literature
- Review of literature
- ✓ Draft questionnaire → existing approaches & tools in local organizations, best practices, obstacles when setting up staff/ volunteer care structures (≠ staff care needs of local staff/volunteers)











Literature review

- Collection of 59 academic articles
- Research questions:
 - What are effective **strategies to support national or local actors** at different levels (individual, peer to peer, organizational)?
 - What are recommendations for how policy makers, donors, organizations and MHPSS actors can effectively support the wellbeing of national staff?
- 29 articles selected
- To Do: Review of grey literature, manuals, existing approaches











To Dos & Next steps

- Finalization of literature review
- Review, dissemination and evaluation of questionnaire
 - Dissemination: beginning of 2020
- Exchange with other initiatives (CMINE, Core Humanitarian Standard Alliance, etc.)
- Writing a recommendations paper on staff and volunteer care
 - Start in spring 2020
